

Olympic Pairs Game

A Memory and Matching game.

1. Print out and laminate the 2 sheets of words and pictures.
2. Then cut each sheet into 12 different cards giving 24 cards.
3. Shuffle all cards well then randomly arrange face down onto grid of 4 X 6.
4. Children take turns to turn over a pair of cards to try and find a matching pair of word and picture, get children to discuss words and pictures as they turn them over. If the pair turned over do not match they must be replaced face down again in original position.
5. Play continues until child matches a pair of word/picture cards. Once they have a pair, they keep it and have another turn at turning up a pair of matching cards.
6. Play continues until all cards have been paired up. The winner is the child with the greatest number of paired cards.
